

December 17, 2001 – Concession Agreement signed between Armenian Government and Corporación América S.A.









5. Key Issues in the new Law on Aviation

Provisions Clearly Defined and Regulated:

- ✓ provisions related with state regulatory/authorized bodies
- ✓ functions and authorities of all bodies in the field aviation
- ✓ principals of Airport activity
- ✓ processes of air space organization and air traffic handling
- ✓ Air operator certification procedures (AOC)
- ✓ certification procedures of aircraft crew
- ✓ requirements of aircrafts airworthiness and environmental protection
- ✓ aviation security requirements
- ✓ search and rescue activities
- ✓ investigation procedures of incidents and accidents
- ✓ air transportation and passenger handling processes





Number of countries amended their interstate agreements on air communication, adding there Open Sky related provisions








