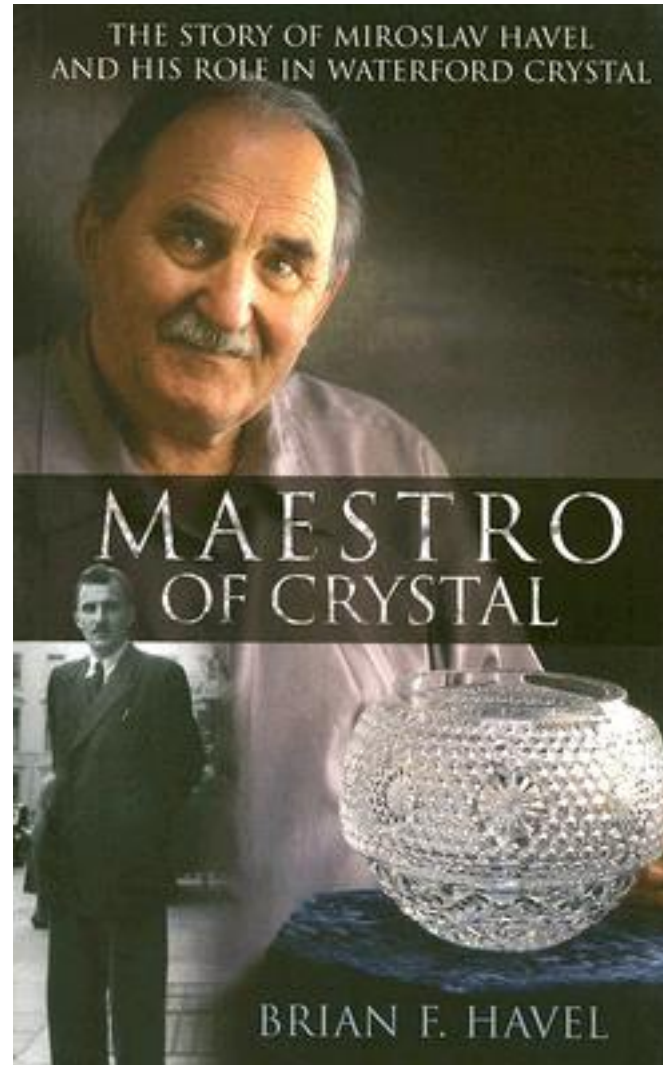

Miroslav Havel, a Glass Master, Is Dead at 86

Miroslav Havel, a glass blower, cutter, engraver, designer, polisher and sculptor who was one of a pair of unlikely Czech immigrants to Ireland who together revived the Waterford glass industry after a century's dormancy,

“Over the years, Mr. Havel became a chandelier maker, cutting the glass for the chandeliers installed in Westminster Abbey in commemoration of its 900th anniversary in 1966, and, at the request of [Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis](#), those in the [John F. Kennedy Center](#) for the Performing Arts.”



Mr. Havel created the **Lismore pattern** seen here in a wine glass, based on designs of the original Waterford glass factory



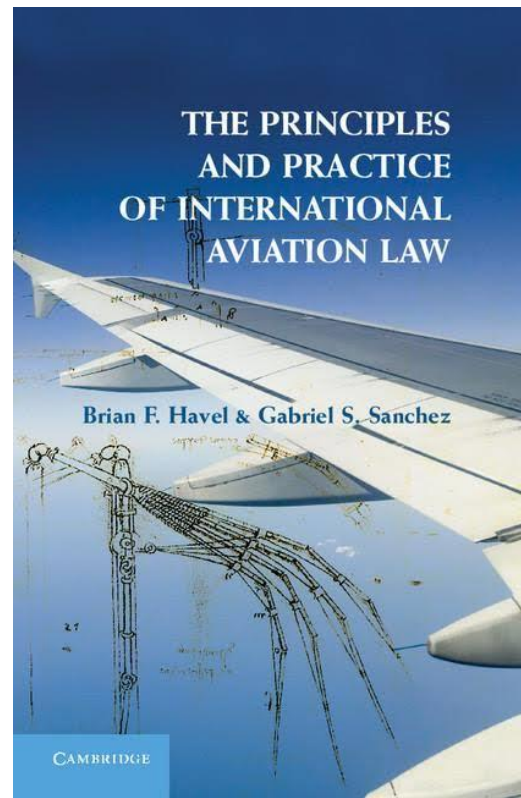

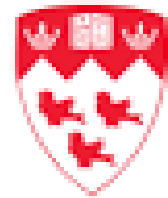
