



who attended an ACI Seminar held at Prague airport.












WHAT IS AIRPORT LAW?





- □ Robust body of law
- □ Unusual compared to many other legal disciplines (e.g. Aviation Law) because statutes, formal regulations, and case law, even combined, represent a relatively small portion of the body of the law.
- □ **Diversity** of non-traditional sources like *federal agency policy papers*, *guidance, directives, opinions*, *advisory publications, research papers and best practices*.


















Why is AIRPORT LAW IMPORTANT?
